The afterschool sports timetable is below but there is also gaming and crafts that will be running if children do not wish to participate in the sports.

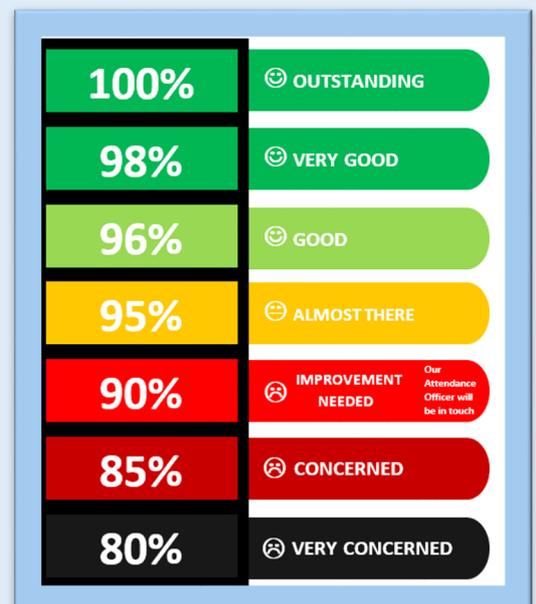
